# **Eagle Ski Club Archives**

Basic catalogue of contents of archive compiled by John Barnard (archivist@eagleskiclub.org.uk). This is very much a preliminary effort at this stage, and my plan is ultimately to create a full itemised catalogue, with accession numbers allocated to each item. I also plan to scan selected items from the hardcopy material, so that they can be made available to the membership via the website.

Archive is currently contained in eight 35-litre plastic boxes (numbered 1-8) and five cardboard storage boxes (numbered 9-13) labelled "EAGLE SKI CLUB Archives" and kept at the Archivist's house. Two sets of bound Yearbooks are shelved at the Archivist's house, and one set is shelved at the former Yearbook editor Mike Hendry's house.

Donated material from Terry Hartley (box 9), John Harding (box 10) and Jeremy Whitehead (boxes 11-13) stll requires considerable sorting and weeding.

Secretarial material since 2005 (which is mainly in electronic form) still needs to be added. The Archivist already retains most of this material from his time as Secretary and President, and committee and AGM Minutes from 2010 onwards are on the club website.
