## **Equipment List**

Waterproof, breathable jacket

Waterproof trousers ski pants

Warm Gloves and lighter gloves

Thermal Top and spare

Mid-layer top

Soft shell jacket

Medium weight down jacket

Mountain trousers or long johns

Warm hat

Ski socks (calf length) and spares

Buff, neck sock

Map and compass – (optional)

Altimeter (watch) and GPS (optional)

Head torch (small LED type)

Rucksack 40 litres

Small personal first aid kit (tape for blisters and pain killers such as aspirin or ibuprofen)

Water Bottle (1 to 1.5 litres recommended)

Sunglasses (Cat 4 rating is preferable) with retaining strap (e.g. Chums)

Goggles (lenses for flat light, poor weather)

Sun cream (factor 25+, total block) and lip block

Sun Hat

Toothbrush/toothpaste

T shirt for evening hut wear

Money, Passport, Alpine Club/BMC membership if you are a member

Sheet sleeping bag (silk)- obligatory in the huts

Ear plugs - optional

Camera, mobile phone and charger

Approach shoes - travelling and evening wear (These can be left in hotel)

## **Technical Equipment**

- \*Ice axe
- \*Crampons
- \*Harness
- \*Screwgate karabiner x3 and a long sling
- \*Prussiks
- \*Avalanche Transceiver and spare batteries. Mammut (Barryvox S or Pulse recommended),
- \*Snow shovel
- \*Avalanche probe

Helmet (optional)

\*Can be rented, but please contact me prior to reserve.

I will supply ropes, group shelter, emergency radio, repair and first aid kit. I will have the maps and navigation tools.

## **SKI EQUIPMENT**

Skis with ski touring bindings. Ski brakes are strongly recommended.

Ski touring boots

Ski Poles - fixed length are better than the telescopic as they are stronger. Big snow baskets essential.

Ski Crampons (also called harscheisen or couteau) are an essential touring equipment.

Skins - If these are cut to fit the ski then that is an advantage. It is important to only have the ski edges showing at the ski waist when the skins are fitted)

Ski scraper and wax for skins!
