Money, Passport, Alpine Club/BMC membership if you are a member

Sheet sleeping bag (silk)- obligatory in most huts

Ear plugs - optional

Camera

Approach shoes - travelling and evening wear

Spare clothes for wearing in the valley

Phone and charger

Technical Equipment

- *Boot Crampons
- *Harness
- *Screwgate karabiner and a long sling
- *Avalanche Transceiver and spare batteries. Mammut (Barryvox S, S2, or Pulse recommended),
- *Snow shovel
- *Avalanche probe

Helmet (optional)

Ski scraper and wax for skis/skins

SKI EQUIPMENT

Skis with ski touring bindings. Ski brakes are strongly recommended. Leashes are also recommended as we will be skiing on a glacier.

Ski touring boots

Ski Poles - fixed length are better than the telescopic as they are stronger. Big snow baskets essential.

Ski Crampons (also called harscheisen or couteau) are an essential touring accessory Skins - If these are cut to fit the ski then that is an advantage. It is important to only have the ski edges showing at the ski waist when the skins are fitted).
