## **Equipment List**

Waterproof, breathable jacket

Waterproof trousers ski pants

Warm Gloves and lighter gloves

Thermal Top and spares

Mid-layer top

Soft shell jacket

Warm down jacket

Ski trousers and / or long johns

Warm hat

Ski socks (calf length) and spares

Buff, neck sock

Map and compass – (optional)

Altimeter (watch) and GPS (optional)

Head torch (small LED type)

Rucksack 40 litres, ideally with compartment for shovel and probe.

Small personal first aid kit (tape for blisters and pain killers such as aspirin or ibuprofen)

Water Bottle (1 to 1.5 litres recommended) or thermos flask

Sunglasses (Cat 4 rating is preferable) with retaining strap.

Goggles (lenses for flat light, poor weather)

Sun cream and lip block

Camera, mobile phone and charger

Approach shoes - travelling

Evening and travel clothes

## **Technical Equipment**

- \*Avalanche Transceiver and spare batteries. Mammut (Barryvox S or Pulse recommended),
- \*Snow shovel
- \*Avalanche probe

Helmet (optional)

## **SKI TOURING EQUIPMENT**

Skis with ski touring bindings. Ski brakes are strongly recommended.

Ski touring boots

Ski Poles - fixed length are better than the telescopic as they are stronger. Big snow baskets essential.

Ski Crampons (also called harscheisen or couteau) are an essential touring equipment.

Skins - If these are cut to fit the ski then that is an advantage. It is important to only have the ski edges showing at the ski waist when the skins are fitted)

Ski scraper and wax for skins!
