Getting to the ESC 2021 AGM

This year's AGM will be held at 17:30 hrs on Saturday 6th November at the Mecure Lambert Arms, London Road, Aston Rowant, Oxfordshire, OX49 5SQ. (http://www.lambertarms.co.uk).

The hotel is located close to Junction 6 of the M40 and is easily accessible by bus (Oxford Tube service from London Victoria, or the Oxford to London airports buses), rail with main line stations at Princes Risborough or Haddenham and Thame Parkway, or private car.

By bus:

The London to Oxford buses, the Oxford Tube , stop at Lewknor Turn, which is a 10 minutes walk from the bus stop at M40 Junction 6. The timetable is available at https://www.oxfordtube.com/tubetimes.asp . It's a 24 hour service with buses every 10 – 15 minutes during most of the weekend, and hourly late at night and early in the morning.

The Oxford to London airport buses also stop at Lewknor Turn. The timetable is at: https://www.theairlineoxford.co.uk/wp-content/uploads/2021/09/20210921 the airlineV2.pdf

The hotel is 5 to 10 minutes walk from the bus stop depending which direction you are travelling from. If you are coming from London, walk north along the B 4009, under the motorway then turn left along the A40 and the hotel is on your left (10 minutes); if you are coming from Oxford walk north along the B4009 with the M40 at your back, turn left along the A40 to the hotel (5 minutes)

By train:

The closest main line stations are Princes Risborough (10-15 minutes by taxi) and Haddenham and Thame Parkway (15-20 minutes by taxi), there are taxi ranks at both stations. Both stations are on the Chiltern line running between London Marylebone and Birmingham Moor Street. Time tables are available at https://timetables.chilternrailways.co.uk/#/timetables/538/Table%202

By car:

Easiest is to leave the M40, exit at Junction 6, drive north along the B4009 (direction Princes Risborough), and turn left on the A40 (direction Oxford, with the Chilterns at your back). The hotel is a few hundred metres from the motorway junction.
